

Lesson Four

Additional Angelic Correspondences

In addition to the correspondences given previously, you can now start to expand your understanding and usage of items that relate to the Angelic planetary vibrations. There is an occult law of correspondence, or of “signatures,” which states that certain colors, numbers, symbols, fragrances, metals etc. correspond to the divine planetary and angelic rays.

A simple way to use some of these correspondences and further attune yourself to the angelic rays, is to begin to wear angelic colors in your daily clothing which correspond to your birth angels and/or the angel of any particular day of the week. You can choose colognes and perfumes (even commercial fragrances) that have “notes” or fragrance profiles that seem to speak to you of the angel’s energy to which you are attuning. You can also choose jewelry items that are sacred to your birth angels and/or the angel of each day of the week. For instance, if you are wanting to connect to Gabriel during your day on Monday, you can consciously incorporate some article of white or silver colored clothing or undergarment, some piece of silver jewelry or a stone sacred to Gabriel, and some perfume that has a fragrance profile that speaks to you of “white flowers,” jasmine or the like.

In your magical rituals, it is recommended that you begin to slowly add more elements to your rituals. Learn to use the angelic colors with altar cloths, candles (except where noted), stones, crystals, metals, herbs, oils, incenses and perfumes, inks, paints, colored pencils, flowers, ritual clothing colors etc.

Choosing a Tarot card sacred to the angel you are working with and placing it on your altar is a very simple yet powerful method of attuning your working space to your angel. Meditating for a few minutes each day on the symbols of the tarot cards of your birth angels is an extremely powerful method of tuning into their power as well. When using Tarot cards for magical purposes, it is recommended that you use a deck based on proper occult symbolism such as the Rider Waite deck (or one of its clones), or the BOTA deck etc. The Marseille decks also have some good symbolism in them. Some of the modern reinterpretations of Tarot, while quite

lovely, are not as helpful for this type of work due to the fact that many of their designers seem to have been unfamiliar with occult symbology.

Using crystals or stones on your altar, using specific numbers of items sacred to the angel you are working with, burning an incense, or wearing a perfume that corresponds to the angelic energies are all ways that you can bring an even greater focus and power into your magic.

It is not necessary that you be overly elaborate; but as you feel comfortable, slowly expand your repertoire of ritual items to your rituals. In addition to tuning into the angelic energies, you are also making a much greater impact on your own deep mind, which is a major catalyst for change in your life.

Start to think creatively about how you can incorporate different correspondences into your rituals. For instance, if you are working with your Solar and Lunar birth angels, plus a third angel, consider calling them by chanting their names using the musical notes suggested. For instance if you were calling on Raphael, and your solar angel was Michael and your lunar angel was Anael, you could make a little song out of the invocation by singing: "Michael (on the note Mi), Anael (on Fa) Raphael (on So).

You could also repeat the name of the angel you are calling for their sacred number. For instance, you could call Gabriel's name nine times.

When working with Anael on a Friday, you could have a rose colored cloth and pink roses in a vase.

For Sachiël, you may want to use a cornucopia on your altar filled with things like grapes, almonds, olives and figs. You could use purple flowers and an amethyst on your altar, and beat a drum 4 times at the opening and closing of your ritual.

For Samael, perhaps you will have a kerosene lamp burning (maybe even with a red glass), the Emperor tarot card before it, and a small bit of Dragon's Blood resin burning in your thurible. You may consider having a libation of some deep red wine as well.

There are truly numerous ways that you can start to work with the angelic correspondences to deepen your practice. Avoid being overly dogmatic about it. Do your best to follow the basic logic of correspondences, and then use your own creativity to apply the correspondences you feel most drawn toward working with. The more correspondences you use, the more focussed your rituals become. Just be sure you don't start to put a lot of pressure on yourself. Find a good balance between being complete yet streamlined. As with all magic, a light touch and a good humor is best.

Ritual of Transmutation

As you become more versed and experienced in magic, you will notice that many of challenges of your natal astrological chart become much less prominent, as well as troubles and worries that are commonly encountered by transiting planets. Some of the most challenging transiting planets for people are Saturn, Mars, Uranus and Neptune.

When Saturn makes hard aspects to power points in a chart, delays, poverty, hard times and difficult lessons are common. Mars brings accidents, fights, ill tempers, and rash behaviors. Uranus brings sudden upheavals, divorces, and outlandish eccentric behaviors. Neptune brings delusion and unfounded fears.

Often these problems are the result of what is commonly called “karma.” These planets are harbingers of hard lessons. However, they are for the purpose of teaching, not punishment, and most often our hard lessons only last for a period of time. Each of these planets, like all planets, have their positive sides as well.

Most people who are not on the Path, need to learn through tough lessons, since they have no way of finding purpose or learn their lessons without them. Yet through magic, we are beginning to find ways to learn our lessons through joy rather than struggle, and we are equipped with the means to begin to “overrule” many of the ill effects of these planets, by finding the lessons, learning them consciously, and then using magic to transmute the ill effects and “flip the poles” so-to-speak into the more positive expressions of these planets.

Transmutation is a form of alchemy. The planet that rules alchemy is Mercury, and thus the Angel Raphael. With occult knowledge, and perseverance, we are able to transmute the malefic manifestations of these karmic planets. We do this through a simple Mercury ritual with Raphael.


When you are suffering a problem that seems to be turning into a long-term ordeal or pattern, start working this ritual each Wednesday until it has transformed. It does not matter which lunar phase or time of day you work it, but avoid eclipses.

This ritual is centered around the symbol for the planet Mercury. You will draw each part of the Mercury symbol separately as shown, and then finally draw the completed symbol in the center of your paper. Then you will, in the Rivers Script, write the following: “Angel Raphael, transmute this ordeal (or trouble, problem, etc) into an experience of lasting gain and achievement.”

Remember to repeat this ritual every Wednesday until you notice that it has been transmuted into something new and positive.

Note: don’t draw the numbers on your diagram. Those are only there to show you the sequence that you will draw them.

Talisman of Transmutation



1. Upright crescent horns of Mercury
2. Circle of events
3. Positive Pole of Creation
4. Negative Pole of Manifestation
5. Completed symbol of Mercury
 - a. Create this talisman either on white paper in yellow ink, pencil or crayon, or on yellow paper in black drawing and writing.
 - b. Draw each symbol in order
 - c. Write the following invocation to Raphael below it in the Rivers script: **“Angel Raphael, transmute this ordeal (or trouble, problem, etc) into an experience of lasting gain and achievement.”**
 - d. Tear up (don’t burn) your paper immediately after you finish your ritual.

Personal Angelic Pentagram

This magical tool is at once a protective amulet, a power center for you, and a magical tool. To make it, you will be using your two primary birth angels, solar and lunar, which you already know. In addition we will be working with other angels who were present at your birth.

First, look up which day of the week you were born on. The day of the week is easy to figure out using any online almanac such as <http://www.dayoftheweek.org>. The angel who rules that day of the week is your "Angel of the Day." For instance, if you were born on a Thursday, Sachiel is your Angel of the Day.

Next, we want to know which angel was ruling your ascendent. If you know the time of day which you were born, simply consult a free online chart casting service such as <http://alabe.com/freechart/> and take note of your ascendant. Use the same process to determine the angel of your ascendent as you did for determining your Solar and Lunar angels (see the handout from week one). This is your "Ascending Angel."

Next you will want to use the table of Angelic Hours from lesson two and find which angelic hour was occurring during the time of your birth. Remember to subtract one hour if you were born during any type of daylight savings time, or "summer time." This is your "Angel of the Hour."

If you don't know your time of birth, simply use Raphael for both your Ascending Angel, and your Angel of the Hour (remember that Raphael is the messenger).

There are a total of five angelic stations which were filled at the time of your birth: Solar, Lunar, Ascending, Hour, and Day. You may have 5 separate angels, or you may notice that you have more than station filled by the same angel. This is absolutely fine. Some people have only one or two angels in all five stations, while others have more.

Create the pentagram on a waxing moon on the day of either your Solar or Lunar angel (whichever you prefer). On a piece of plain white paper or card stock, draw the pentagram in either black or using the color of the angel on whose day you have chosen to work.

Next place the planetary symbol in each section of the diagram as shown, using the appropriate planetary color for each. Color in the background of each section using a lighter shade of planetary color. For instance, I would take a dark red colored pencil for making the Mars symbol for Samael, and then a light red or even pink crayon to lightly color in the background of that section of the pentagram. For Anael, I might use an Emerald Green pencil for the Venus symbol, and pale pink or coral for the background. For Sachiel, perhaps a dark blue for the Jupiter symbol, and a pale lavender for the background. For Uriel, I would use different colors for each part of the Uranus symbol, and a rainbow effect for the background etc. Use your own imagination and artistic sensibilities, doing your best to stay within the basic planetary coloring schemes.

Finish your pentagram by filling in your name in Theban Script in the center section. You may use colors of the angel of the day you are using, or other colors as you desire for this section.

This pentagram should be put away and kept safe in the room where you work your magic.

An excellent use for this diagram is for healing the body. Notice that each section of the pentagram represents a different part of your body: the top is the head, the two sides are your right and left arms, the center is your torso and the bottom sections are your right and left legs.

Whenever you have an ailment, find the angel who rules that part of the body. On that angel's day of the week, draw on a white piece of paper the part of the pentagram that represents that section of the body. Cut around the outside of the lines you just drew so that the piece of paper matches the shape of the drawing. Draw the planetary symbol of that angel in the center of your little paper, in the appropriate angelic color. Very briefly write in an angelic script what you want, either next to the symbol or on the reverse side of the paper (i.e. "heal left hand"). Then place this little talisman you made on top of your Angelic Pentagram, directly on top of the section of the pentagram it represents. Leave this in place until you have achieved your healing.

Alternately, you may do this operation in conjunction with your Lunar Tablet (see lesson from week one). If you are using the waning moon tablet, simply destroy the little paper along with your waning tablet. If you are using the waxing moon tablet, with the little paper placed properly on your Angelic Pentagram, just place your completed invoking tablet on top of both, and leave them undisturbed until the following new moon. Destroy the invoking tablet and the little talisman together on the new moon.

Obviously since this is using your personal Angelic Pentagram, this method is only appropriate for healing yourself, not another person.


Be sure to put your Angelic Pentagram away after each use.

You may want to consider laminating your pentagram to protect it from being soiled. If your pentagram gets damaged or soiled, it's perfectly fine to make a new one. Just be sure to destroy the old one after doing so.

Even when you are not using your Personal Angelic Pentagram for healing, its presence in your working room is a source of magic, empowerment and protection. It's quite appropriate to place it on your altar whenever you are working your magic. You may also want to simply meditate on your pentagram as a sort of "mandala" as well.



If a person was born with their sun in Aries, their moon in Sagittarius, Leo Ascending, in the angelic hour of Aquarius and on a Friday, their completed star would look like this:



Sections of The Pentagram:

Draw a single section of the pentagram to represent the part of your body you are healing. Draw the planetary symbol which rules the body part or illness you are healing. Cut around the outline to make a little talisman. Then place this little piece of paper directly on top of the same part of your Angelic Pentagram when working your personal healing magic. When in doubt of an angelic ruler, remember that Raphael is both the Messenger and the Angel of Healing, so he is always appropriate to work with for all healing work.
